

BYLAW NO. 2010-10

A NOISE CONTROL BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Clavet enacts as follows:

1. No person shall operate, or allow to be operated, any equipment powered by an engine or motor of any type; i.e lawn mower, rototiller, chain saw, skill saw, snow clearing devise, in any residential district between the hours of :
 - (a) 11:00 o'clock in the evening and 7:00 o'clock of the next morning on weekdays and;
 - (b) 11:00 o'clock in the evening and 9:00 o'clock in the morning of the following day which is Saturday, Sunday or a holiday.
2. No person shall operate, or play, or allow to be played, any radio, tape player, CD player, television, musical instrument, or any other devise used for the amplification of sound, either in or on private premises in a residential district in such a manner that the same can be easily heard by an individual who is not on the same premises from which such sound emanates.
3. No person shall allow any diesel motor including a tractor which pulls a trailer or a semi-trailer truck to remain running longer than 10 minutes during the months of April 1-October 31st and for no longer than 30 minutes during the months of November 1 – March 31st while the tractor-trailer, or tractor alone, is stationary in the Village of Clavet.
4. Any person found guilty of a breach of any provision of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the Voluntary Payment Bylaw No. 2010-08 of the Village of Clavet.
5. Bylaws No. 2001-05 and 2010-04 are hereby repealed.
6. This bylaw shall come into effect and take force upon approval of Council.
